In addition the responding personnel were able to restrict the flame spread (damage) to the initial room where the fire started over 50% of the time.

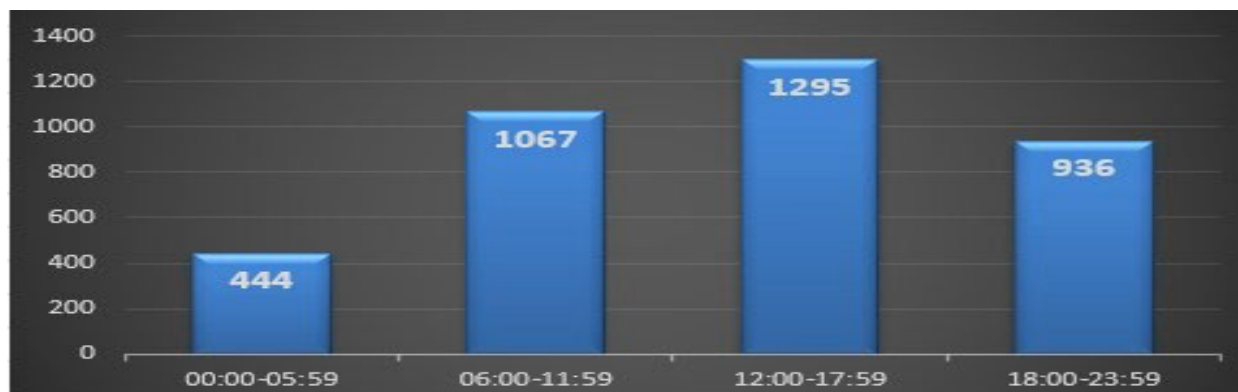
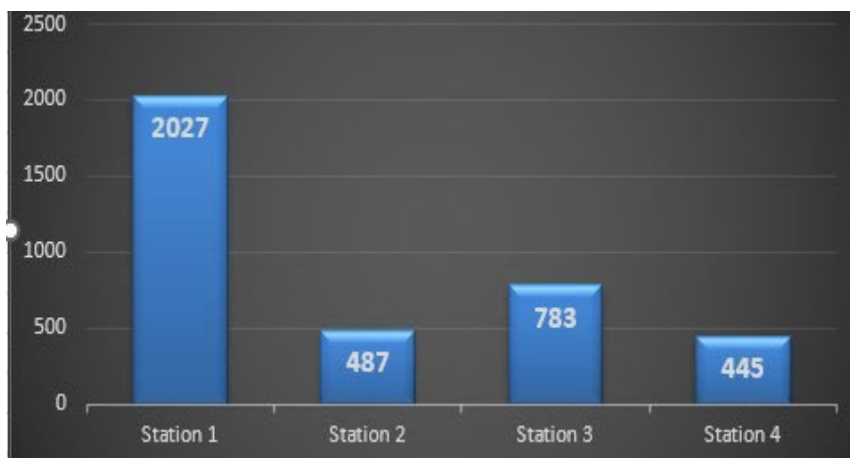
